## 2006 IOWA CONFERENCE BASEBALL PREVIEW

**CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA**... Wartburg College, with seven starters, four pitchers and 19 letterwinners returning from last season's top-four national finishing team, is the pick of the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) baseball coaches to win its 10th straight Conference title.

The Knights received seven of nine first-place votes and accumulated 69 points to claim the top spot in the 2006 IIAC baseball Coaches' Poll. Coe College received one first-place vote and is second in the preseason poll with 57 points, followed closely by Central College with 56 points. Simpson College received the final first-place vote and is tied for fourth in the Coaches' Poll with Buena Vista (50 points)

**Top Returning Players:** One former American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) All-American, nine former ABCA All-Central Region players and 19 former All-Conference performers return to their team's line-up this year. Wartburg senior pitcher **Matt Scherbring**, the 2005 Conference MVP and First Team All-Conference selection, is a two-time All-Region pick and was named an ABCA Third Team All-American. He leads a group of five All-Region and All-Conference performers returning to the Knights line-up this year. Senior catcher **Brian Greiner** is a two-time Second Team All-Region selection and a 2004 Second Team All-Conference. Senior pitcher **Ryan Moorman**, a three-time All-Conference pick, was a 2005 Second Team All-Region pick. Junior second baseman **Marc Numedahl** and senior short stop **Casey Pauli** were Third Team All-Region last season and First and Second Team All-Conference picks, respectively.

Coe has two All-Region and four All-Conference players returning. Senior designated hitter **Will Renner** was a 2004 Third Team All-Region selection and a Second Team All-Conference selection. Senior first baseman **Chad Kramer** was a 2005 Second Team All-Region selection. Senior pitcher **Brandon Hunt** and sophomore designated hitter **Cody Smith** were Second Team All-Conference picks.

Central senior catcher/left fielder **Adam Duerfeldt** was a Third Team All-Region selection last year and Cornell senior pitcher **Ryan Rosenberg** was a Second Team All-Region selection in 2003. Duerfeldt was named Second Team All-Conference last year while Rosenberg has earned All-Conference honors twice.

Other returning All-Conference players include: Buena Vista senior second baseman **Derek Fink** and senior outfielder **Joe Poole**; Central senior outfielder **Shea Stamp**, a two-time selection, and senior pitcher **Matt Rohach** (2004); Loras senior pitcher **Matt Mausser** and senior infielder **Dustin Roth** (2003); and Simpson senior outfielder **James Brown**, senior short stop **Dusty Kain** (2004) and senior catcher **John Clanton** (2003).

*National Polls:* Wartburg is ranked third in the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA)/Collegiate Baseball Newspaper's preseason poll. The Knights rank behind the College of Wooster and defending national runner-up Cortland State University.

*Conference Doubleheaders:* Conference doubleheaders are scheduled for one seven-inning and one nine-inning contest. If game one of the doubleheader (the seven-inning game) exceeds 2-hours 40-minutes in length, game two will revert to a seven-inning game.

*Conference Tournament:* The 2006 Iowa Conference baseball Tournament is May 11-13, at Veterans Memorial Stadium in Cedar Rapids. Loras College is the host of this year's Tournament.
