2008 IOWA CONFERENCE WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIPS PREVIEW

CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA . . . The 2008 Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) Wrestling Championships are Thursday, February 21, at Wartburg College in Waverly, Iowa. Matches begin at 10 a.m. inside Levick Arena with the finals set for 7 p.m. following the Grand March at 6:30 p.m.

Iowa Public Television (IPTV) will televise the Championship finals live across the state beginning at 7:00 p.m. **Tim Johnson** will provide the play-by-play and former national champion wrestlers **Jim Gibbons** and **Dan Gable** will provide analysis. For local IPTV stations, visit IPTV's web site at www.iptv.org.

National Polls: Six Iowa Conference schools and 24 individuals are ranked in the latest National Wrestling Coaches Association/Brute-Adidas poll released on February 12. Ranked teams are Wartburg (1st), Coe (8th), Buena Vista (10th), Luther (12th), Dubuque (19th), and Loras (21st).

All 10 weight classes have at least one Iowa Conference wrestler ranked in the top-8, including nine classes with at least two wrestlers. Four IIAC wrestlers are among the top-8 at 157-pounds, while three other weights (125, 133, and 184) each have three IIAC wrestlers listed in the rankings. Wartburg has eight wrestlers ranked. Buena Vista has five ranked wrestlers and Coe has four. Cornell, Luther, and Loras each have two, while Dubuque rounds out the list with one ranked wrestler.

2007 IIAC Championships Recap: Wartburg College won its 15th consecutive Iowa Conference title last season. The Knights amassed 181 points as they claimed their 25th overall title by 21 markers over runner-up Luther College, which finished second for the seventh time in eight years. The 21-point margin of victory is the closest since 1994 when Wartburg defeated Buena Vista (158.75-138) and the 160 points by Luther is the most by the Conference runner-up. Wartburg claimed five individual titles, Luther crowned three individual champions, and Buena Vista and Coe each had one wrestler claim the top spot on the awards stand.

Five former Conference Champions return to their teams' line-up this year. Wartburg's **T.J. Miller**, the defending national champion at 197 pounds, will look to become the 37th wrestler to win at least three Iowa Conference championships since 1965. Buena Vista's **Jestin Hulegaard** (133), Wartburg's **Aaron Wernimont** (157) and **Romeo Djoumessi** (184) will also defend titles earned last winter, while Wartburg's **Jacob Naig**, who was sidelined last season by an injury, was the champion at 149 pounds and Outstanding Wrestler of the 2006 meet.

Fifteen of the Conference's 32 national qualifiers, and 11 of 19 All-Americans from 2007 return to their teams' line-ups in 2008. Hulegaard will look to qualify for nationals for the fourth time in his career, having earned All-American honors each year. T.J. Miller, Naig, Cornell's **Chris Heilman**, Loras' **Jay Figgins**, and Luther's **Alec Bonander** and **John Miller** are each looking for their third trip to nationals. Naig, T.J. Miller, and Heilman are each two-time All-Americans. T.J. Miller leads a group of six returning Knight national qualifiers. Luther and Cornell each have three returning national qualifiers, while Buena Vista, Coe, Loras, and Simpson each have one qualifier in their line-up.

Thirty-two IIAC wrestlers will qualify for the NCAA Championship field of 160, the top-three in each weight class and two wildcards. The 2008 NCAA Division III Wrestling Championships will be hosted by Coe College, Cornell College, and the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference at the U.S. Cellular Center in Cedar Rapids March 7-8.

A class-by-class preview follows with each school's probable line-up. Championship brackets will be posted on Wartburg's Championships Web site (<http://www.go-knights.net/2008IIACwrestling/index.html>) and the Iowa Conference Web site (www.iowaconference.com) on Thursday morning and the web site will be updated with results throughout the day.

The second-, third, and fifth-ranked wrestlers in the nation hail from the IIAC in Cornell's **Chris Heilman**, Coe's **Clayton Rush**, and Wartburg's Robert **Struthers**. Heilman, who has spent most of the year ranked second in the nation, finished second in the Conference last year after fourth-place finishes in 2005 and 2006. Rush began the year unranked but has steadily climbed the rankings, spending the last three weeks at No. 3. Struthers, who has been ranked all season, finished fourth a year ago. Loras' **Mark Beatty** took fifth last year as a freshman.

This weight class also has three ranked wrestlers in Wartburg's **Jake Helvey**, Cornell's **Nick Nothern** and Buena Vista's **Jestin Hulegaard**. Hulegaard has finished first (2007), second (2005) and third (2006) in the weight class the last three years and is a three-time All-American. Helvey, last year's runner-up, took fifth at the national meet to earn All-America honors. Coe's **Gannon Hjerleid** took fifth last season, but bounced back at national to place eighth. Loras' **Jordan Loy** and Luther's **Zach Bartlett** both competed at 133 last year, finishing fourth and sixth, respectively.

Wartburg's **Matt Kelly** is currently ranked third in the nation. Luther's **Travis Grawin**, who has also spent much of the year ranked, finished third last season and fourth in 2006. Coe's **Niles Mercer**, fourth in the Conference at 149-pounds last year, was a national qualifier at 141 in 2006. Buena Vista's **Luke Satern** is currently ranked eighth. Central's **Nick Johnson** (133-pounds in 2007) has previous Conference Championship experience.

Two-time All-American **Jacob Naig** is currently the top-ranked wrestler in Division III at 149-pounds. He missed last year's meet with an injury after finishing first and being named the meet's Outstanding Wrestler in 2006. Naig, who also finished fourth in 2005, is a two-time All-American with a runner-up finish in 2006. Simpson's **Curtis Barber** finished third last year and qualified for nationals. Buena Vista's Aaron Cook competed in the IIAC Championship at 165-pounds in 2006.

Six of the nine competitors in the draw have spent time in the national rankings this season. Wartburg's **Aaron Wernimont**, the defending IIAC Champion and an All-American last year, is currently the top ranked wrestler in Division III at 157. Loras' **Erik Hanson**, who finished fifth at 149 last year, is ranked sixth. Dubuque's **Josh Terrell** and Buena Vista's **Joey Verschoor** are ranked eighth and ninth, respectively. Cornell All-American **Pat McAuley**, who was ranked most of the season and peaked at No. 3, has consecutive top-three finishes at 157 and wrestled at 149 in 2005. Coe's **Bryan Grothus**, who finished fourth at 165 last year and sixth at the same weight the previous year, also cracked the top-10 at 157 this season.

Coe's **Tyler Burkle**, fifth at 157 last year, is currently ranked third nationally at 165. Wartburg's **Justin Hanson** was ranked nationally at one point during the year. Dubuque's **Darrin Kaisand** is a three-time competitor in the Conference Championship, finishing fourth at 174 in 2006 and sixth at 157 in 2005 and at 165 last year. Central's **Kevin Yeoman** participated in last year's Conference Championship, while Cornell's **Drew Vickers** participated in the 2006 tournament.

Buena Vista's **Josh Murray** is the highest ranked wrestler in the most current rankings at eighth, followed closely by Coe's **Tyler Jentz** at ninth. Murray has competed at 174 the past two seasons. Jentz finished third at 157 in 2005 and fourth at 174 last year. Cornell's **Kyle Kehrli** is unranked but has been as high as sixth this season. He has competed at 174 each of the past three seasons. Luther's **A.J. Gregg** competed at 184 in 2006 and has been ranked at both 174 and 184 this season. Loras' **Brandon Bauer** placed fifth at 174 last season. Wartburg's **Craig Kreman** has spent a week in the national rankings this season.

Wartburg All-American and defending IIAC champion **Romeo Djoumessi** is ranked first in the nation. Loras' **Jay Figgins** and Coe's **Greg Lalla** rank eighth and ninth, respectively, in the nation. Figgins finished fifth at 197 in 2006 and second at 184 last season, qualifying for nationals each year. Lalla finished fourth at 184 each of the past two seasons. Dubuque's **Matt Wonderlin**, who was ranked for part of this season, wrestled at 184 in 2005 and 2006, finishing third in 2006.

Wartburg's **T.J. Miller** and Luther's **Alec Bonander** are ranked first and second, respectively in the nation. The pair have swapped the top spot back-and-forth over the course of the season. Miller is the defending national champion, a two-time IIAC champ, and a two-time All-American at 197. Bonander, a two-time NCAA qualifier, took fourth at the 2006 IIAC meet before posting a runner-up finish last season. Coe's **Rob Kramer**, who took fourth at 197 at last year's Conference Championship is unranked but has been as high as ninth this year. Dubuque's **Cesar Dominguez** and Simpson's **Sam Collora** both competed in last year's Conference Championship.
