Iowa Conference Baseball Players of the Week April 26-May 2, 2010



Position Player: Mike Stephenson, Buena Vista Univ., Omaha, Neb./Skutt Catholic
Stephenson, a senior second baseman, finished the week as BVU's leading hitter (.588) with at least one hit in each of the Beavers' five games, including three multi-hit outings. Four of his 10 hits were doubles after having had only two doubles all season coming into the week. He also turned in seven RBIs, including at least one in each game, and has now driven in a run in six straight games and nine of his last 10. Stephenson was perfect in 32 chances in the field during the week and has made only one error in 160 attempts at second base this season.

Pitcher: Cody Hyland, Luther College, Winnebago, Minn./Blue Earth Area

Hyland, a senior pitcher, picked up a pair of complete-game victories during the week, defeating Wartburg, 3-1, on April 27, and Cornell, 4-0, on May 1. In 14 innings, he scattered one run on six hits, walked two, and struck out nine.
