## IOWA CONFERENCE WOMEN'S TENNIS TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW

**CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA . . .** The 2009 Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IAC) Women's Tennis Championship begins this weekend, October 9-10, at the Hawkeye Tennis and Recreation Complex in Iowa City. The six-school Team Championship was seeded by a vote of the Conference women's tennis coaches. All nine Conference schools will participate in next weekend's Individual Tournament to be held at the Veterans Memorial Tennis Complex and at Coe College.

Three-time defending champion Coe College has the only unblemished league mark at 8-0 overall and 5-0 in IAC play. Luther College wrapped up its fall schedule with a 12-2 mark overall and a 7-1 mark in league play with their only IAC loss coming to the Kohawks. Wartburg College sits third at 12-3 overall and 6-1 in the IAC. Central College (8-6, 5-3 IAC), Cornell College (6-8, 2-4 IAC) and Loras College (7-9, 4-4 IAC) have also been selected for the IAC Team Tournament field. Simpson College (3-12, 3-6 IAC), University of Dubuque (3-13, 1-7 IAC), and Buena Vista University (0-9, 0-7 IAC) round out the Iowa Conference standings.

The dual matches will start with doubles and conclude once a team wins five points and are played out to determine place finishes one through six. All matches will take place at the Don Klotz Tennis Courts at the Hawkeye Tennis and Recreation Complex with the exception of Saturday's fifth-place match, which will be at Clark Racquet Center on the campus of Coe College in Cedar Rapids at 9 a.m. The top four teams from this weekend will advance to next May's Iowa Conference NCAA Automatic Qualifier Tournament to determine the recipient of the league's automatic berth in the 2010 NCAA Division III Women's Tennis Championship field.

**2008 Team Tournament Recap:** Coe College captured its third consecutive Iowa Conference women's tennis title with a 5-2 win over No. 2-seed Luther Saturday at the University of Iowa's Don Klotz Outdoor Courts. With the victory, the top-seeded Kohawks earned the opportunity to host the Conference's Automatic Qualifier Tournament where the Norse returned the favor and captured the IAC's automatic berth to the 2009 NCAA Division III Women's Tennis Championship with a 5-2 victory.

The Kohawks captured two out of three doubles matches to lead by a single point heading into singles play. **Hillary Allen** put Coe up 3-1 with a 6-1, 6-0 win at No. 4 singles, only to see Luther's **Cami Czech** register a 6-1, 6-4 win at No. 6 to draw the Norse back within one. Four-time IAC MVP **Molly Fiala** edged Coe closer to the title with a 6-3, 6-0 win at No. 1 and doubles partner **Andrea Schupbach** closed out the match with a 6-1, 1-6, 1-0 (5) win at No. 3 singles.

No. 4 seed Central edged No. 3 Cornell, 5-3, for third place, while Simpson took fifth place with a 5-2 win over Wartburg Saturday morning. In the third-place match, the Dutch overcame a 2-1 deficit following doubles with four singles wins.


